The Mayor invited members of the audience and those participating via Zoom the opportunity to “raise their hand” to provide public comment.

No comments were offered.

Ordinance No. 23-66, by Mrs. Moore, authorizing the City to accept an Ohio Public Works Integrating Committee (OPWIC) zero interest loan in the amount of \$2 million from the State Capital Improvement Program (SCIP) for the construction of the Lynnfield/Lomond Sanitary Sewer Overflow (SSO) Project, and declaring an emergency.

Public Works Director Patricia Speese stated that a year ago today the Public Works Department sought Council approval to seek grant funding from the Ohio Public Works Integrating Committee (OPWIC) in the form of a \$1 million grant and a \$1 million zero interest loan. However, the grant funding had been exhausted before our project was scored, but they still had funding to give us a \$2 million zero interest loan. With the inflation rates last year and this year that was a great option for this project. This project has been in the works for almost three years. The design took almost two years with the funding taking another year and a half. The engineer’s estimate is \$6.6 million and with the \$2 million zero interest loan we will have accumulated \$7.6 million for the project. Prices always come in higher than expected but if
