

ORDINANCE NO. 24-40

Amending Section 141.22 of the Administrative Code of the Shaker Heights Codified Ordinances relative to Thornton Park Ice Rink Fees, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, Section 141.22 was most recently amended in Ordinance No. 22-21, enacted on February, 28, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the City's Thornton Park Ice Rink general admission fees, learn to skate fees, and hourly rental fees were most recently reviewed and adjusted in 2019, and were previously updated in 2013 and 2008; and youth hockey program fees were most recently reviewed and adjusted in 2022, and were previously updated in 2019, 2013, 2008, and 2007; and

WHEREAS, periodic review and adjustment of ice rink fees allows the Recreation Department to ensure cost recovery through collected fees and, therefore, after such a review the Director of Recreation recommends that Council increase certain fees for the Thornton Park Ice Rink.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Shaker Heights, State of Ohio:

Section 1. Section 141.22 of the Administrative Code of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Shaker Heights as heretofore in effect is hereby repealed.

Section 2. Section 141.22 of the Administrative Code of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Shaker Heights is hereby enacted as amended as follows:

141.22 THORNTON PARK ICE RINK FEES.

(a) The fees charged for the youth hockey program at Thornton Park Ice Rink ~~beginning January 1, 2020~~ shall be:

The Director of Recreation shall determine the definition of prime and non-prime times, and the terms and conditions for hourly rental.

(d) Any employee of a business located in Shaker Heights who works at the Shaker Heights location shall be considered a "Resident" for the purpose of this Section.

Section 3. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare for the reason that it is necessary in the current operation of the City, so that hockey registration can begin on May 8, and further, to expedite the change to the ordinance for fall program promotion which includes high usage at the rink, and, therefore, this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its enactment and approval by the Mayor.
