

# Explore Shaker

## HILDANA PARK

Located just south of Chagrin Boulevard between Ludgate Road and Hildana Road, Hildana Park is a hidden gem of the Moreland neighborhood. Visitors to the park can relax and take a break in one of the chairs of hope, a series of painted Adirondack chairs designed by local students. The park also features a Little Free Library for exchanging books within the community and a number of tables for playing chess or backgammon. There's also two solar powered Wi-Fi benches, which give neighborhood residents the opportunity to bring school or work outdoors when the weather is great! One of the most striking features of Hildana Park is the large and colorful public art piece entitled "Standing Balance." This structure features a number of brightly colored doors, each designed to reflect those found in the Moreland neighborhood, with the two peaks building an uppercase M.
