

ORDINANCE NO. 23-86

Amending Section 141.18 of the Administrative Code of the Shaker Heights Codified Ordinances relative to Thornton Park Pool fees, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, Section 141.18 was most recently amended in Ordinance No. 18-57, enacted on June 25, 2018; and

WHEREAS, this Council has determined to change the current Thornton Park Pool pass and daily admission fees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Shaker Heights, State of Ohio:

Section 1. Section 141.18 of the Administrative Code of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Shaker Heights as heretofore in effect is hereby repealed.

Section 2. Section 141.18 of the Administrative Code of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Shaker Heights is hereby enacted as amended as follows:

141.18 THORNTON PARK SWIMMING POOL FEES.

(a) The daily admission fees for the use of Thornton Park swimming pool for residents, including residents of the City and School District, and non-resident guests, who must be accompanied by a resident to be admitted, shall be:

Any employee of a business located in Shaker Heights who works at the Shaker Heights location shall be considered a "Resident" for the purpose of this sub-Section. The Director of Recreation may establish rules for the use of Thornton Park Pool by non-residents.

~~(e) The Short-Term (5-day) Pool Pass for the use of the Thornton Park Swimming Pool for non-resident guests (who are related to the resident and live more than 50 miles from Thornton Park) shall be:~~

Preschool	\$17.50

Adult	\$45.00
Senior	\$42.50.

~~The Short-Term Guest Pass must be purchased by the resident. Any employee of a business located in Shaker Heights who works at the Shaker Heights location shall be considered a "resident" for the purpose of this sub-Section. The Director of Recreation may establish rules for determining eligibility for the Short-Term (5-day) Pool Pass.~~

~~When a toddler or pre-school (Ages 0-5) pass is obtained, it must be accompanied by the purchase of an adult or family pool pass.~~

Section 3. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare for the reason that it is necessary in the current operation of the City and further, to expedite the change to the ordinance so that staff may proceed with production of the Winter Catalog which provides detailed information on Thornton Park Pool Passes which go on sale after the first of

the year, and, therefore, this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its enactment and approval by the Mayor.
